Jude Morrison began playing violin at the age of 6, after much cajoling to his parents. His pleas received credence after a “petting zoo” experience at the Portland Symphony Orchestra Discovery Concert, where he was informed he was a natural with string instruments, and the violist implored his parents to allow him to take lessons. Since then, he has studied with Deirdre Oehrtmann, of the Portland Symphony Orchestra, following the Suzuki method. Jude has attended the Advanced Suzuki Institute (Stanford, CT), Ithaca Suzuki Institute, and the New England Suzuki Institute, as well as festivals in Maine and Massachusetts. He is currently the assistant principal second violin with the Portland Youth Symphony Orchestra. This is his fourth year participating in the USM Youth Ensemble program. Jude also regularly performs at St. Ann’s in Windham, and on warm summer evenings you might find him in the Old Port playing Suzuki favorites, with a little Star Wars mixed in for good measure.

Jett Morrison began playing violin at the age of 4. After attending his brother Jude’s lessons for a year, he was primed to begin playing on his own. Jett studies the Suzuki method with Deirdre Oehrtmann, of the Portland Symphony Orchestra. He has attended the Advanced Suzuki Institute (Stanford, CT), Ithaca Suzuki Institute, and the New England Suzuki Institute, as well as festivals in Maine and Massachusetts. Jett is currently the assistant concertmaster with the Portland Youth Junior Orchestra. This is his third year participating in the USM Youth Ensemble program. Jett also regularly performs at St. Ann’s in Windham, with a special love of the Christmas Eve program, and he enjoys regaling his friends at Levey Day School with *Shipping Up to Boston* by the Dropkick Murphys.
